

### A New E-QUAL Collaborative | Frequently Asked Questions

### What is the focus of the new collaborative?

The Opioid Management Learning Collaborative, with the support from the Addiction Policy Forum and Yale University, aims to recruit EDs nationwide to:

- Collaborate on opioid-focused interventions
- Develop a best-practice toolkit
- Collect data on quality
- Assess the state of ED and hospital care
- Study the effectiveness of engaging EDs in quality improvement
- The learning collaborative will help EDs implement alternatives to opioids (ALTO), improve opioid prescribing, and adopt harm reduction strategies such as naloxone prescribing and medication assisted therapies



#### How does participation work?

- Your ED joins through enrollment on our portal
- One ED contact (Champion) interacts with the portal and reports Improvement Activities (IA) which are completed
- The Champion will complete activities over a 6-month period.
- These include activities engaging all eligible providers, such as sharing webinars, podcasts, and performance data.
- Implementation:
  - Target clinician focus on 'big' problems
  - Develop local capacity for quality improvement
  - Create momentum for practice transformation

## What are the benefits of participating in E-QUAL?

- Earn IA credit for the CMS MIPS program
- Submit and receive benchmarking data in real-time
- Feature you ED's QI efforts to hospital leaders and payers
- Gain access to toolkits including best practices, sample guidelines, and key talking points
- Get access to high-quality eCME for free
- Earn ABEM MOC credit (LLSA and Part IV Activities)
- Focus on participation & improvement

### <u>Can an individual clinician</u> <u>participate in E-QUAL?</u>

- Individual clinicians can view webinars and receive CME credit.
- To receive IA credit, clinicians must participate as a group.
