The Emergency quality Network (E-QUAL), through the support of the Center of Medicare and Medicaid Innovation's Transforming Clinical Practice Initiative has been developed to help support hospital leaders both inside and outside the C-suite address this challenge. The effort, directed at improving outcomes for patients with sepsis, reducing avoidable imaging in low risk patients, and improving value of ED chest pain evaluation, will ensure physician and clinician engagement, and help align metrics and strategies for quality improvement. By providing hospital leadership with tools for front line change agents, E-QUAL can help hospitals support your contracted and employed physician staff in achieving the triple aim of better health outcomes, more effective health care and lower cost.

This effort will help institutions benchmark their performance with peer organizations on these national measures, network with hospital leaders in this space and ensure compliance with CMS MIPS requirements, as well as The Joint Commission standards related to ongoing professional practice evaluation.
