Jeremiah (Jay) Schuur, MD, MHS, is a practicing emergency physician with a research focus on health care quality and policy. Dr. Schuur is the Vice Chair of Clinical Affairs and Chief of the Division of Health Policy Translation for the Department of Emergency Medicine of the Brigham and Women's Hospital and an Assistant Professor of Emergency Medicine at Harvard Medical School.

Dr. Schuur's research focuses on quality of care and patient safety in emergency medicine and the intersection of emergency care and health policy. He has been funded by the governmental agencies and foundations including the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, the Patient Centered Outcomes Research Institute, the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. He is currently co-leading ACEP's 4-year \$4 million E-QUAL network, a national quality network funded by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Innovation. He has published over 100 peer-reviewed manuscripts.

Dr. Schuur has served on national committees involved in quality, safety and health policy. He has chaired the Quality and Patient Safety Committee of the American College of Emergency Physicians (ACEP), and was appointed to the Medicare Evidence Development & Coverage Advisory Committee (MEDCAC).
