- 1. Convene and guide key volunteer roles at the chapter level (i.e. advocacy champion, communications, membership recruitment, resident engagement, group ambassador) and ensure that these roles are continually informed and engaged to share best practices and advance shared national/chapter goals.
- 2. Create a curriculum for chapter leader education to include in-person (Leadership & Advocacy Conference and Scientific Assembly) and virtual opportunities. Connect chapter leaders to opportunities to learn from their shared opportunities and challenges.
- 3. Explore the relationship between ACEP and its chapters and develop recommendations to establish shared accountability for 1) chapters to provide consistent member value, 2) ACEP to provide sufficient support to the chapters and 3) continued growth and sustainability.
- 4. Serve as a resource to State Legislative/Regulatory Committee in their objective to host at least two roundtable discussions for chapter leaders as an opportunity to make connections and to learn from each other's experiences dealing with similar issues or launching new initiatives. (State Legislative/Regulatory is the lead committee.)
- 5. Designate a liaison to the State Legislative Committee.
