

1. Copyright & Usage Rights

By submitting an image, the contributor confirms they are the copyright holder and grants the **American College of Emergency Physicians (ACEP)** the following permissions:

- The right to display the image publicly at the **ACEP Scientific Assembly**.
- An unrestricted, royalty-free license to use the image for **marketing and promotional purposes**.
- Inclusion of the image in any event photography or videography captured during the Scientific Assembly.

2. Technical Specifications

To ensure clarity for both digital display and print, images must meet these standards:

- **Format:** High-resolution **JPEG** or **PNG** files only.
- **Resolution:** Minimum of **300 DPI** (dots per inch).
- **Content:** All submissions must be strictly **educational** and directly relevant to the clinical or operational practice of **emergency medicine**.

3. Patient Consent & Privacy

The protection of patient identity is our highest priority.

- **Consent:** Patient consent is recommended for all clinical images. If obtained, documentation of this consent should be maintained on file by the submitter and made available to ACEP upon request.
- **De-identification:** All images of subjects must be fully de-identified. Please ensure the following are removed from the image:
 - Photos of a patient's face or full body
 - Images showing a patient's name or hospital wristband.
 - Pictures of identifying tattoos, scars, or birthmarks.
 - Identifying metadata or descriptions tied to a patient.
