FAQs

How do I access my free EM:RAP account provided by EMRA?

- You will first need to log into your EMRA account by navigating to <https://www.emra.org/>.
- Once logged in, you will click on "Benefits," in the top nav bar.
- Scroll down to "EM:RAP."
- Click on "Learn More"
- Click on "Access EM:RAP"
- Just follow the instructions.
- If you try to log in directly from emrap.org, it will tell you your membership has expired.

How do I update contact info in my ACEP/EMRA account?

- To update your information with either ACEP or EMRA, just go to <https://www.acep.org/>.
- Click on the "Sign In" button at the top right.
- If you do not remember your ACEP id, username, or password, just click on the "Forgot Password" hyperlink.
- When logged in, click on the drop-down arrow next to your name in the upper right corner, and choose "My Account."
- Just click on the fields you need to update.
- Your id and username will be the same for both ACEP and EMRA.

How do I access my free membership to the Young Physicians Section (YPS) and add the additional free Section of my choice provided by ACEP?

- Go to <https://www.acep.org/how-we-serve/sections> and login.
- Once logged in, just click on "Join A Section" to choose another Section. The free Young Physicians Section has already been added to your account.
- Each additional Section after your two free ones, are just \$20 each.
