- Greg Minor with FirstNet presented on the benefits and capabilities that FirstNet/AT&T provide to the prehospital community

Board Liaison Remarks Kristin McCabe-Kline, MD, FACEP

- ED accreditation has started, one is already accredited (U of Alabama)
- They have added language into policy about medical malpractice standards
- Education- They are having discussion with ABEM around EMS training criteria, length of training, etc

- Several resolutions
 - Telemedicine - group established, how telemedicine will affect EM

- Working on disaster medicine ABEM subspecialty; if it continues progress, next ABEM board directors meeting is in Feb '26 and announcements on its progress will come after that
- ACEP wrote a letter of support for it; EMS section and disaster medicine section involved.

Sponsor Presentation – Abbott

- Impact of “One Beautiful Bill”: medicaid cuts, more uninsured, higher EMS call volumes and waiting for transports, etc EMS even more safety net than already are. POC (iSTAT) may mitigate that. (Have troponin, lactate, BMP, etc) may decrease transports and continuity of care with transmission of labs to destination

Organizational Updates

NAEMSP – Douglas Kupas, MD, FACEP

-Firing of NEMSAC council (advocacy council)- 7 members of NAEMSP on that board that were fired. Opportunity to build it back better. Partnering with other organizations to build it with multiorganizational ties.

-9 EMS organizations were at a legislation conference recently promoting EMS to staffers and legislation

-New member benefit - Free access to legal council; two options - 1. closed email about general topics, answers will go out to the whole group; or 2. you can contact directly and they will give specific legal council

- There are now resident and student interest group within NAEMSP (meets monthly)

-The NAEMSP Prehospital Trauma Compendium is almost complete

-Come to Tampa - 2026 NAEMSP last week in January (Jan 26-31)

NCDMPH – Jeffrey Freeman, PhD

-Consolidations of NCDMPH, CGHE, and DIMO - into HIDMC; Supports military and civilian health operations; both a federal organization and academic institute.

- National disaster medical system pilot program - continuing this

- Indo pacific medical readiness program - developing a more robust medical readiness program in the indopacific.

-NIHTSA prehospital blood program - large multi-year program to launch this nationwide

-Council of Chief Medical Offices- consolidated organization more hospital based input to government

-Disaster medicine lecture series - webinars related to disaster medicine; next one on Sept 16 1 pm

-Nation at Risk symposium - panel discussion on sept 9th 3 pm

ASPR TRACIE – Rachel Lehman

- Healthcare emergency preparedness resources- Has many resources to assist EMS in the field related to disaster medicine/Emergency preparedness

-Has came up with a “EMS ID playbook”

- HPP Supplemental Guidance and EMS Cyber and Downtime Assessment.

-Looking for subject matter experts to help peer review their information- reach out if interested

PHBTIC – Jon R. Krohmer, MD, FACEP, FAEMS

-Blood coalition coming together to develop resources, share information and promote prehospital blood use.
