KEY DASHBOARD METRICS

- Emergency department encounters by age group
- Percentage of patients aged 65+ years who are boarding for more than 4 hours
- Inpatient admissions from the ED for patients aged 65+ years
- All-cause 30-day same-ED revisits for patients aged 65+ years
- Mean length of stay for patients aged 65+ years
- Number of select screenings performed in accordance with the GED model
