 - zoom polling ask questions such as where are you from? Idea of renaming yourself, include a mixture of practice settings, locations, as well as some whimsical polls as well.
 - polling (whether internal polling software or external such as Sli.do or polleverywhere (more software = increased chance of tech failure / lack of engagement)
 - * About themselves:

* Private chat: (builds on name change) pick someone from your geographic area/same setting/ different setting/background you like/etc. and send them a Q privately *have a clear timeframe; software won't do it*

- Another idea that we did not discuss in the meeting for networking: do you think that attendees would want to share/have other geri-EM people's contact info? If so, we can disseminate a Google form where ppl can add their info and consent to sharing them.
- Finally, allowing space for the participants to talk is huge in terms of their satisfaction as long as we do not put anyone on the spot and we have a structure to avoid running overtime.
