 - Discussion on resolutions – support of vaccines, support of scientific integrity at CDC, discussion of grants from EMF to non-EM participants getting grants

 - Discussion about what other avenues UHMS can pursue (ie, Learning Lounge, Drop the Mic, and Critical Decisions) to get their specialty noticed.

 - Topis in pipeline – CRAO, “Lessons Learned,” FDA update and chamber safety

- The Section Crawl was discussed. 2nd annual Section Hall Crawl was successful with good conversations and discussions.
- Update on Board Certification — American Board of Preventative Medicine manages the test for board certification
- Discussion of 2 deaths in US in hyperbaric chambers – both unaccredited facilities. FDA instructions release on Aug 25, essentially, they are tracking this issue and recommend following manufacturer recommendations.
- Approval of new ACEP Section operational guidelines – 100% approved
- Future actions
 - Stephen Hendriksen will follow up on a CDEM article, and write a “lessons learned as chair” article for the newsletter
 - Chris Allen will look into a newsletter article on chamber safety and the FDA notice and possibly pitch an article to the EIC of ACEP Now. He will also follow up with the Wilderness Medicine section on a possible SIM lab at the next SA. He will follow up with prehospital medical student group on possible diving lecture, and post a reminder in EngagED about the course deadlines for ACEP26.

 - Abby Winn will write an article about HBOT and CO₂ toxicity
