Congrats on graduating!! We know the process can be overwhelming and we want to remind you that we are here to help. Below is a checklist of all the dates and things to get done AFTER residency graduation and don't worry if you lose this it's all available on our Young Physicians Section Website.

- ✓ May/June 2020 Graduate from residency & Get a new job
- ❑ Secure your state license for your future job (remember this could take as much as 6 months!) & register license with state (some states require this)
- ❑ May 1 - Oct 27 2020 - Register & pay \$960 for your Qualifying (written) Exam www.abem.org
- ❑ July /Aug 2020 - Schedule your Qualifying exam at www.pearsonvue.com/abem
- ❑ November 9 - 14 2020 - take your Qualifying exam
- ❑ Feb 10 - March 9 2020 - register for Spring Oral exam and pay \$1,255
- ❑ May 2 - 5 2020 - Take Spring Oral Exam
- ❑ July 27 - Aug 26 2020 - register for Fall Oral exam and pay \$1,255
- ❑ Oct 10 - 13 2020 - Take Fall Oral Exam
- ❑ Jun or Dec 2021 - get your Oral Board results & become a Board Certified Emergency Medicine Physician!!
- ❑ Renew ACEP membership
- ❑ Learn about how to maintain your board certification: LLSA/Concert or MyEMCert (more to come on that)

FINISHING RESIDENCY CHECKLIST

Sept-Jan

- Search & apply & interview for new job
- Research disability insurance & apply (rates go UP after graduation) more info at acep.org/yps

Feb-March

- Sign contract for new job
- Start applying for state license for your future job by googling the state medical board (could be up to 6 months!)
- Start Credentialing paperwork with your new hospital (also takes awhile)

April

- Complete your last resident taxes
- Consider Loan Consolidation (ACEP & EMRA have discounts)
- Start apartment/home shopping
- Finish turning in all paperwork you can for state license and new hospital credentialing

May

- Register for your Qualifying (written) Exam & pay \$960 at www.abem.org (registration ends Oct 27 2020)
- Consider applying for Student Loan Consolidation (ACEP & EMRA have discounts)
- Apply for permanent DEA licensure in your state (MUST have state license #- takes 6-12 weeks, might not be able to start your job until you have this number!)

June

- Graduate from residency
- Move to your new location
- Update your new information at ABEM, ACEP, and other places
